



CCPI DEMAND-SIDE SUPPORTER PLEDGE

***Supporters** of the Code for Construction Product Information (CCPI) are companies that use or specify products in the construction and maintenance of the built environment. Being a CCPI **Supporter** means you are committed to the aims of the Code to raise standards in construction product information and move the industry to a place where product information is clear, accurate, up-to-date, accessible and unambiguous.*

Supporters can be contractors using products, such as Tier One contractors and sub-contractors; professionals such as architects, structural engineers, surveyors, consultants, planners; interested organisations like Local Authorities who procure construction builds and maintenance; or clients and investors.

The critical factor for Supporters is that they want to deploy products that are supplied with product information independently assessed as conforming to the CCPI. The CCPI critically helps companies raise their standards in terms of product information creation and management. CCPI Supporters want to have greater confidence in the information provided by manufacturers when making design decisions, installing and using products, and maintaining the built environment. Independent assessment of conformance with the CCPI helps to give greater confidence in product information. This will support the industry to continue to develop quality buildings that meet performance standards.

What does being a CCPI Supporter mean?

As a CCPI Demand-Side Supporter, the registered organisation commits publicly that they will require *strategic suppliers and manufacturers of construction products in their supply chain to ensure that those products are either assessed by the CCPI or undergoing the CCPI assessment process.

Supporters of the Code are organisations that share CCPI's vision of delivering positive change to the built environment industry. To this end, they will, wherever possible:

- Encourage their suppliers and manufacturers to ensure their products achieve CCPI assessment.
- Introduce this commitment into supply agreements as a preference.
- Prioritise working with suppliers and manufacturers who prioritise delivery of CCPI assessment and conformance.
- Expect *strategic suppliers and manufacturers to have achieved CCPI conformance by December 2026, (or within three years of the CCPI Supporter signing their CCPI Supporter Pledge).

Supporters will also:

- Proactively promote CCPI within their supply chain.
- Report twice-yearly to CCPI their progress and delivery against the pledge.
- Raise awareness of their role as a CCPI Demand-Side Supporter to encourage others to join this community of organisations working to raise standards, according to the agreed CCPI guidelines in relation to CCPI Demand-Side logo use and public claims.

Please note:

* 'Strategic suppliers and manufacturers' – is to be defined in agreement with each company named as a Supporter with the expectation that it will include companies that regularly supply products to the company and will include the manufacturers of materials as well as intermediary merchant and distributors in the supply chain.

- Supporters who have registered will be able to display their CCPI supporter logo on their website and other appropriate documents in accordance with CPI Ltd permitted use guidelines. Current Supporters include:
